EMERGENCY PROVISION for children of Critical Workers and Vulnerable Children

Those of you who registered your role as a Critical Worker via our online form can now book places for the rest of the week (Thursday onwards) via the Eventbrite links below. A reminder that:

- **This provision is a last resort.**
- **Every child who can be safely cared for at home should be.**
- There is **no** requirement for parents and carers to send their children to school if they do not need to do so.
- The provision is only for 'Critical Workers' and identified vulnerable children **and ONLY IF THERE IS NO OTHER PROVISION AVAILABLE AT HOME.**

If you did not register your role as a Critical Worker, then the electronic form to do so is on the Covid-19 section of the website (please note, the form will close for new submissions shortly). **Please note you are not able to book the emergency provision (via the links below) without having first completed the Critical Worker form.**

We are grateful to those parents/carers who were able to provide alternative, safe, childcare arrangements at home so that the number of staff and students on site today was able to be minimal to support the reduction in the risk of transmission between staff, students and the local community.
